<b>Unit 1</b>	<b>Where Are You From?</b>	<b>Lesson 2 / p. 11</b>

Time	Content	Key Teaching Points
<b>2 min</b>	Roll Call	- Check the attendance.
<b>5 min</b>	Vocabulary review	- Use the flashcards to review the vocabulary.
<b>5 min</b>	Vocabulary and grammar structure review with song	- Review the vocabulary and structure by singing the song from the previous lesson
<b>5-10 min</b>	Listening I . Listen and write.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Have students open their books to page 11. Focus students' attention on the comic strip in the Listening section on page 11.</li> <li>- Explain to the children that they will now listen to the story, and that they should read along and point at the words with their finger while they listen.</li> <li>- Explain to the students that they need to complete this section by listening and completing the information.</li> <li>- Play track 06 and have students listen and write to complete the sentences. Review the correct answers as a class</li> </ul>
<b>10-15 min</b>	Listening II. Say and Act.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Explain to students that they will act out the story. Randomly assign character roles or ask for volunteers.</li> <li>- Next, ask students questions about the plot, setting, and characters in the story, and what they think is happening.</li> <li>- Practice the lines of the story with the students according to their role a few times.</li> <li>- Act out the story.</li> </ul>
<b>5-10 min</b>	Listening III. Read and Check.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Have students read the sentences and mark a check-mark for the sentences that are correct.</li> <li>- Check answers together as a class.</li> <li>- Ask students to give corrections for the sentences that are wrong.</li> </ul>
<b>3-5 min</b>	Homework	- Workbook p.7
