Catholic women had to cover their hair with a veil in church until the 1960s. Sikh men wear turbans. A turban is a (10) long piece of cloth wrapped around the head.

The Dragon Hill Spa is a (1) very interesting place in Korea. There are many (2) things to do.

People can go in (3) different rooms after they (4) take a bath. Some rooms are hot, and some rooms are cold. There is a room with (5) rocks on the floor. It is very warm. Also, there is a very cold ice room.

Some families like to go on the (6) weekend. They can eat snacks (7) together and talk with (8) each other. They can play games, read books, and watch (9) movies. They can even (10) sleep on the floor.

Unit 4 Colors for Brides

What color should a (1) wedding dress be? Women from (2) different cultures wear different colors.

(3) Women in China and India wear red wedding dresses. In these countries, red

(4) represents being happy.

Women in Europe and (5) North America like to wear white wedding dresses. In 1840, Queen Victoria (6) wore a white wedding dress. After that, (7) brides started to wear white, too.

(8) Before 1840, brides in Spain wore black. A black dress represented being married until

(9) death. Brides in Ireland wore blue. Blue represented being pure.

(10) As you can see, colors can mean different things to different people.

Unit 5 Robot Animals

(1) Robot animals do amazing things to help us.

Robot birds fly into (2) dangerous places. They tell us (3) when it is safe to go there. They

(4) send messages to people using Wi-Fi. Robot birds can also keep a place (5) safe.

Some airports use robot birds to (6) make sure the planes do not hit birds in the sky.

Some robot fish help us with (7) nature. They look for (8) water pollution. This helps keep

the water clean. Others (9) take pictures with their eyes. They swim with other fish in the

ocean. We can (10) learn about the ocean and the fish.

Unit 6 Sorts of Coral

There are different (1) sorts of coral. Corals live in oceans. They look like plants, but they are animals. They stay in one place.

One sort of coral has (2) tentacles. (3) Tentacles look like noodles. They (4) catch food for the coral. This kind of coral lives in cold, (5) deep water.

Other corals live together with small (6) plants called algae. This kind of coral makes (7) its own food. It needs (8) sunlight to grow its food. It lives in warm, (9) shallow water.

These two sorts of coral live in different places, but (10) both make the ocean look beautiful.

Unit 7 Water Giants

The (1) largest animal in the world is the blue whale. It is also the largest (2) mammal on Earth.

Even blue whale (3) calves are enormous creatures. A blue whale calf is born (4) weighing about 2,000 kilograms. That is the (5) same as a small car! Every day in its (6) first year, it gets 91 kilograms (7) heavier.

Blue whales are (8) meat eaters. They eat 40 million (9) shrimp-like creatures called krill every day. They eat about 3,600 (10) kilograms of krill in just one day.

Unit 8 Camel Humps

Camels have (1) humps on their backs. The humps are (2) made of fat. Some camels have one hump, (3) while others have two humps.

One-hump camels have short hair and come from the Middle (4) East. Two-hump camels have (5) longer hair and come from Mongolia. (6) Both places are dry and have many (7) deserts. It is hard to find food.

Camels can live (8) for weeks with no food. They use the fat in their humps. So camels can (9) carry heavy supplies across a desert (10) even if they do not eat. When a camel uses all the fat, the hump becomes soft and hangs down.

Unit 9 Skiing in Space

Did you know that (1) you can ski in space? (2) Astronauts want to ski on the Moon.

Astronaut Jim Irwin said the Moon (3) looks like a (4) ski resort!

Mons Hadley and Mons Hadley Delta are two (5) mountains on the Moon. There is deep,

(6) soft dust all (7) over these mountains. Astronaut John Young said it is like (8) snow.

The (9) next time he goes to the Moon, astronaut Harrison Schmitt said he will ski.

He will first (10) bounce up a mountain. Then he can ski down.

Unit 10 Seasonal Sports

Some people like summer because of the hot (1) weather. Some people like winter because of the cold weather. There are some people (2) who like both seasons. They can (3) surf in summer, and they snowboard in winter.

You surf (4) in the ocean, and you snowboard (5) on the mountain. But these two sports are (6) similar. First, you need a board. Also, you need strong legs for (7) both.

You (8) stand sideways on a board. You keep your (9) body low. You use your body to (10) turn. You can go fast and do big jumps in the air.

Unit 11 Soccer Tennis

People in (1) Asia love to play (2) soccer tennis. Famous soccer players often play it, too.

Playing it makes their soccer skills better.

In soccer tennis, two teams play (3) each other. The teams have a (4) net between them.

To start, one player kicks the ball (5) over the net. The other team (6) kicks the ball back.

They can kick the ball three (7) times before it goes over the net. Players can't use their

hands. Also, the ball can only (8) hit the ground one time between kicks. If the ball hits the

ground (9) more than one time, the other team gets a (10) point.

Unit 12 Sportsmanship

Venus and Serena Williams (1) are sisters. They are also both (2) tennis players.

The sisters play each other sometimes. In 2001, the two sisters played in the US Open.

They played each other in the (3) championship match. Venus won that time. But (4) over the next two years, they played each other in four other championship matches. Serena won all of (5) those!

You (6) might assume they get (7) angry with each other when one of them (8) loses. But Serena says, "Family's first, and that's (9) what matters the most." The sisters' love for each other goes (10) deeper than the game of tennis.

Unit 13 Good Listeners

Sometimes people (1) may have a problem at home or at school. They may have a problem with their (2) health. They may not feel good about something. They need someone to talk (3) to.

Psychologists are (4) good listeners. It's their job to (5) listen to people and ask about their thoughts and (6) feelings. They can give people (7) advice. Getting advice can (8) help people feel better.

Psychologists are (9) good at communicating with people. Some people are shy. Psychologists can do (10) activities with these people. They may draw a picture together. They may play music or play a game.

Unit 14 From Hobby to Job

For many (1) people, singing is a hobby. But if you have a very good voice, it can also be a (2) job.

As a job, singers can sing at (3) weddings and parties. They even sing at (4) sports games.

People will (5) pay singers to sing.

Singers also sometimes (6) join a band and become their (7) lead singer. They can (8) travel around the world. Millions of people hear them sing.

This is (9) just one example of (10) how to make a hobby, which many people enjoy, into a job.

Unit 15 Flight Camp

Many children go to (1) summer camp to learn different things.

Some children learn how to (2) camp and fish or how to (3) cook. Others might learn a (4) language. Some even learn how to fly (5) planes.

Children who want to learn how to fly a plane can go to flight camp. They get fifteen (6) hours of flying classes. They also get ten (7) hours of flying time. When they (8) become sixteen, they can get their (9) pilot's license.

(10) If you want to become a pilot someday, this camp can help you do that!

(1) Being a chef is a difficult job. Chefs (2) have to cook many sorts of foods. They have to (3) stand all day and (4) work quickly. But, being a chef can also be (5) interesting and exciting.

Chefs can work in (6) many different sorts of places. They can work in (7) restaurants and hotels. They can also work on a (8) cruise ship. Chefs can travel (9) around the world and work.

Chefs can (10) make a lot of money and make people smile. Chefs work hard to cook delicious food. When people eat good food, they feel happy.
