slab	n.	a thick, flat piece of a hard material	The crust is made of huge slabs of rock called tectonic plates.
against	prep.	moving in the opposite direction	Sometimes plates push against or pull away from each other.
lava	n.	melted rock from a volcano	When magma leaves the volcano, it's called lava .
flow	v.	to move steadily and continuously in one direction	Lava flows on the crust.
erupt	v.	a sudden, violent explosion	One way volcanoes erupt is when plates push against each other.
squeeze	v.	to press something together very tightly on all sides	Volcanoes erupt when magma is squeezed up between two plates.
melt	v.	to change from a solid to a liquid, usually from heating	Magma is super-hot melted rock and gases.

bend	v.	to cause something to become curved	The crust bends down.
form	v.	to cause something to begin to exist in a particular way	The Hawaiian islands formed from volcanoes.
active	adj.	moving or tending to move a lot	Mauna Loa is one of the most active volcanoes on earth.

invent	v.	to make something for the first time	A man named Shai invented "PowerUp 3.0."
control	v.	to direct the actions of something	It's a little machine that can control a paper airplane.
fold	v.	to bend one part of something over or against another part	The first step is to fold a piece of paper in half.
half	adj.	the point or area where two lines or sides meet	Next, fold the paper in half again.
open	v.	to cause something to no longer be covered	Then, open the paper.
corner	n.	an angle that is exactly 90°	Then, fold the outside corners of the triangles to the middle line.
middle	adj.	equally distant from the ends; halfway between two points	Use the middle line.
edge	n.	the part where an object or area begins or ends	Then, bend the edges down.

distance	n	the amount of space between two places or things	It was the shortest distance .
meter	n	the basic metric unit of length	It flew two meters !
