Chocolate is one of the most popular treats in the world. People drink it, eat it as candy, or use it as an ingredient in puddings and cakes. It is a custom in many Western countries for men to give their wives or girlfriends boxes of chocolates as presents. Also, on special occasions, chocolate treats are usually shared among family and friends.

Chocolate comes from the cocoa bean, which grows on the tropical cocoa tree. Europeans first tasted chocolate in the early 1500s when the Spanish invaded Mexico. At this time, Mexico was part of the Aztec Empire. At first, Aztec emperor, Montezuma, welcomed the Spanish general, Cortez, with a chocolate drink. He called the drink “xocolatl”, which means bitter water. Cortez and his men took some of these beans back to Spain with them. It was not long before the drink became popular throughout Europe.

The manufacturing of chocolate from the cocoa bean is a long process. The beans are dried and roasted, and the shells are cracked. The nib—or center of the bean—is separated from the shell, and it is from this that chocolate is made. Other ingredients usually added to chocolate are sugar and sometimes vanilla or milk. This is what makes it sweeter and less bitter.
